

Project Summary and Benefits

The Arizona Department of Transportation will soon begin a reconstruction/widening and erosion control project on SR 87. The project is a component of the Maricopa Association of Governments Regional Transportation Plan (RTP), and will be funded by the RTP and the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act

of 2009. The project is designed to improve traffic flow by widening the roadway, repairing slopes and ditches, reinforcing embankments, and implementing modifications to meet state and federal standards.



What to Expect

The following project will require traffic restrictions on SR 87. Northbound SR 87 will be used as a two-way detour during construction on the southbound lanes. Daytime and nighttime construction activities are expected. Motorists may experience slowing and traffic delays, including temporary closures. ADOT will provide regular project updates via email and on the project Web site located at www.ValleyFreeways.com.

Project Schedule

July 2010 – Anticipated start of construction

September 2010 to May 2011 – Traffic restricted to one lane in each direction on SR 87

July 2011 – Anticipated completion of construction

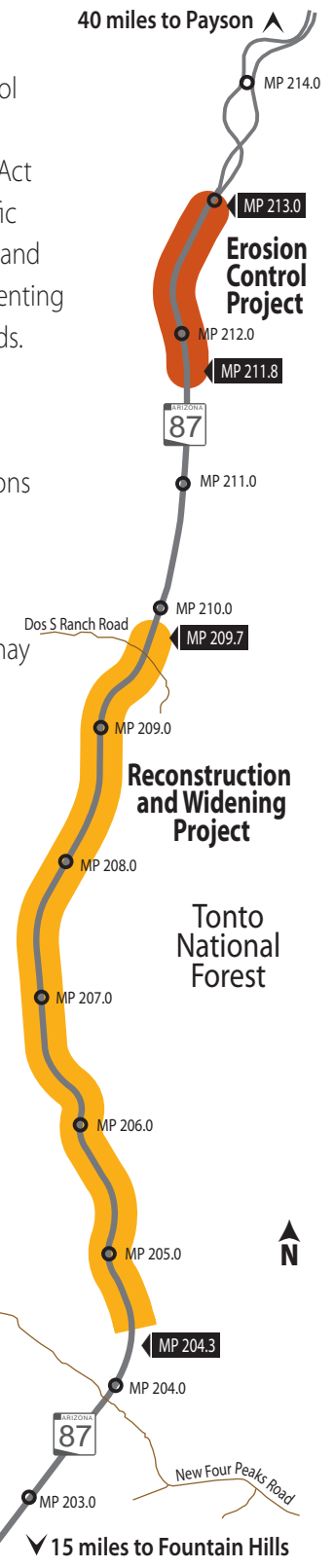
